Registration is now open for the Stanford Institute for Neuro-Innovation and Translational Neurosciences (SINTN) annual neuroscience research conference, November 8-10, 2009. The conference will be held at Pajaro Dunes along the Monterey Coast (www.pajarodunes.com).

The goals of the conference are to share exciting science, foster a sense of community and promote interactions and collaboration among members of the neuroscience community at Stanford. We encourage all members of the neuroscience research community to participate, including faculty, students, postdoctoral fellows, clinicians and research staff.
